

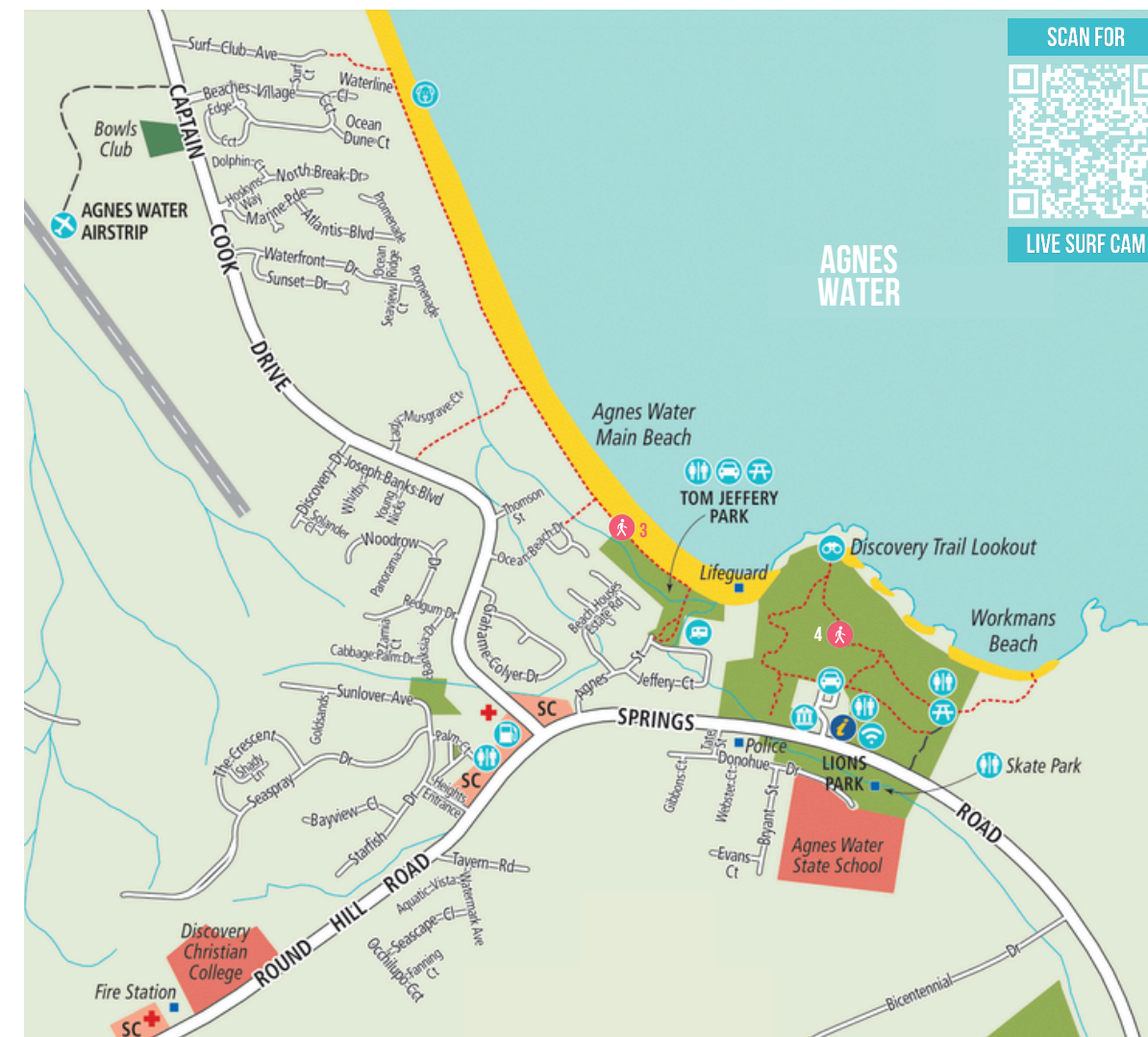

# WALKING TRACKS & LOOKOUTS

REFER TO MAP FOR WALK LOCATIONS | WALKING DISTANCES ARE ONE WAY

## 1. RED ROCK WALKING TRAIL | 2.5KM | INTERMEDIATE | 2.5HR

From the Agnes Water Visitor Information Centre follow Springs Road for 2.5km until you reach a dirt track on the left that leads to Springs Beach. After 800m of dirt trail, you'll find a sign marking the beginning of the track. The beaches and scenery along this trail are superb, so may take several hours to walk if you wish to stop to enjoy. Dogs not permitted.

## 2. 1770 BUTTERFLY WALK | 1.2KM | EASY TO MODERATE | 1HR

Starting at the Captain Cook Monument, walkers can take in the natural beauty of the Joseph Banks Conservation Park by following the track along the shoreline of Round Hill Creek. Throughout the autumn and winter months, the migrating Blue Tiger butterflies are here in abundance. Dogs and domestic pets are not permitted. At the end of this walk you can venture up to the 1770 Headland and explore the short walking trails to the two lookouts.

## 3. AGNES WATER BEACH | 5.5KM | INTERMEDIATE | 2HR

The walk starts at the foot bridge near the parking area at Tom Jeffery Park at Agnes Street and is best to walk on an outgoing tide. Walk along the beach from Agnes Water. Keep an eye out for many species of terns, white-bellied sea eagles, turtles, dolphins and large schools of fish. Dogs are permitted on parts of the walk.

## 4. DISCOVERY TRAIL AT AGNES WATER | 1KM | MODERATE | 30MIN

The entrance to the trail is behind the Museum on Springs Road in Agnes Water. Here you will find a large map in the carpark to view. The walk leads you through bushland to the Agnes Water Lookout, which boasts spectacular views of Agnes Water Beach and Workmans Beach. Dogs are permitted on a leash.

## 5. DISCOVERY TRAIL AT 1770 | INTERMEDIATE | 1HR

Cross intersection at Tupia Street and Banks Drive, Town of 1770 Discovery Trail 1770 is located near the weather station. When the Bustard Lighthouse was unmanned in 1986 the Bureau of meteorology established the weather station at 1770. A lovely conservation park walk featuring rocks and narrow dirt tracks provides a walk for the more adventurous hikers. No Dogs Allowed.

## 6. GANOONGA NOONGA LOOKOUT TRACK | 360M | 1HR

Pass through grassy, open woodland with bloodwood trees and rusty gums on this steep lookout walk. With sensational views over the surrounding coastal lowlands, the steep trip is well worth the effort— just make sure you bring your camera! Enjoy sweeping vistas of Munro Range to the west, and Bray Hills and Bustard Bay to the north. Dogs not permitted.

### DAY 1: ADVENTURE AND REEF

Embark on a full-day trip to Lady Musgrave Island for snorkeling and exploring the reef with 1770 Reef Eco Tours, or get 1770 Dive Spear & Sport take you on an intimate group dive, snorkel or spearfish. Unwind after your day on the water at Agnes Water Tavern with dinner and a cocktail.

### DAY 2: EXPLORATION AND SUNSET

Enjoy the 1770 Headland walking trails from land, before hiring a SUP board kayak to explore the inlet and headland from the water. Re-fuel with a delicious seaside lunch. For a relaxing finish, hop on a sunset cruise, or take a self-guided tour on a BBQ boat to enjoy the golden hour.

### DAY 3: SURFING, TOURS, AND NATURE

Start your day with some history at the Agnes Water Museum and a morning surf, or surf lesson with Stylez or Gnarly Tours Surf School at Agnes Water Main Beach. After, take the 1770 LARC! Afternoon Tour to explore more of the region's coastline and nature. If surfing isn't your thing, opt for a full-day tour, or take a fishing charter to the nearby reefs. End the day at Deepwater or Eurimbula National Park, where you can camp, fish, explore, or continue on with your travels.
